

Is there parking at the DoubleTree Hotel?

Yes, there is plenty of parking. Our designated parking is on the backside of the hotel in the convention area, and that we have a group rate of \$12 per day.

When entering the parking lot, you will retrieve a ticket at the gate, on the ticket it will read "1st Ticket". During registration, we will provide a validated ticket that will read "2nd Ticket", which will discount the parking fee down to \$12.00. At the time of departure, you will insert the 1st ticket, followed by the second ticket and pay the \$12.00. Payment can be made either at the gate, or at any of the parking kiosks inside of the hotel.

Are there alternative transportation options?

The hotel is located near the Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, and provides a complimentary shuttle from the airport. In addition, there is the Link Light Rail station that is approximate two-minute walk to the DoubleTree Hotel. There are also several Metro buses that serve the area. What is the registration costs? What is included in the registration fee?

Save \$50 - Early Bird Registration through **April 30, 2024**.

- Non-Student, employed in WA: \$139 (\$89 early bird)
- Student or trainee in WA: Free*
- Non-Student, NOT employed in WA: \$239 (\$189 early bird)
- Student or trainee NOT in WA: \$139 (\$89 early bird)

The registration includes conference attendance, the welcome reception and two meals. Registration does not include the pre-conference sessions. Pre-conference sessions are an additional cost of \$39.

Are all the conference sessions going to be located in the DoubleTree Hotel?

Yes, all the conference sessions will be located in the DoubleTree Hotel.

What integrated care model will the conference cover?

This conference will be on integrated care in general, and not one specific integrated care model.

What can be paid through a scholarship?
