






50 % or greater improvement in depression at 12 months

IMPACT: Summary

 - Higher quality of life
- 2) Greater patient and provider satisfaction
- 3) More cost-effective







STAR-D Summary

Level 1: Citalopram ~30% in remission

> Level 2: Switch or Augmentation ~50% in remission

> > Level 3: Switch or Augmentation

~60% in remission

Level 4: Stop meds and start new

~70% in remission

Mission





 - o 6 Psychosomatic Medicine fellows
 - o 5 Addiction fellows
- 20 UW Psychiatry Residents
- 497 Attendees for 20 UW PACC Sessions
- 29 cases presented at UW PACC by 20 providers
- 109 Community-Based Psychiatrists received training
